Visiting Program To Indonesia “Explore Yogyakarta” 2017 is an inter-cultural educational program that serves to provide an understanding about the culture and society of its participants. This program enables participants to learn both the Indonesian language and culture alongside exploring the city of Yogyakarta and its surroundings. This program is also beneficial in preparing and building the framework of the ASEAN Community 2015.

Program

1. Basic Indonesian language
2. Cultural tour around the city of Yogyakarta (Borobudur and Prambanan Temple, Sultan Palace)
3. Learn Indonesian traditional dance and making Batik
4. Learn Javanese traditional music (gamelan)
5. Practice the Indonesian language with the locals in their everyday lives
6. Certificate of participation in the program from the Centre for Southeast Asian Social Studies Universitas Gadjah Mada

Language Program (Basic Indonesian Language)

ASEAN Community that is actively started at the end of 2015 will definitely be the harbinger of a big change. ASEAN citizens will now be able to form a big united community that is sought after, in knowing and understanding one another. Besides providing the opportunity, the ASEAN Community 2015 will bound to raise challenges. Some of the challenges include the competition amongst individual ASEAN members, the different languages, and so on. In order to strive in this competition, it is incumbent upon us to master at least one of the Southeast Asian languages. Participants will be partaking in the Indonesian

language classes for a total duration of 42 hours at the Center for Southeast Asian Social Studies and grab the opportunity to interact and have a first-hand experience in communicating and interacting with the locals of Yogyakarta

Cultural trip

The Visiting Program in Yogyakarta will definitely be equipped with several excursion activities – which includes visiting tourists spots like the Borobudur temple, Prambanan temple, Kraton Sultan Palace and Jalan Malioboro. Program participants will also be able to join the Aceh traditional dance lessons, gamelan class and making batik together with the undergraduates from University of Gadjah Mada. This is an opportunity not to be missed in getting to know and understand the Indonesian culture.



Time and venue

This program will be held on July 3rd – July 29th 2017. Throughout this program, during two or three weeks participants will be joining in the basic Indonesian language classes, cultural trips and learning the traditional Indonesian dances and Gamelan at the Center for Southeast Asian Social Studies Universitas Gadjah Mada, Yogyakarta.

Program Fee

In participating in this Visiting Program “Explore Yogyakarta” 2017, participants are required to pay a program fee of USD 450 (basic Indonesian language class, program books, dance and gamelan class, batik class, trip to Borobudur Prambanan, Kraton, Tamansari and Malioboro, snacks and drinks during the program, certificate are included). Transportation from and to Yogyakarta city, accommodation fees and personal expenses are not included in this fee.
